

GOLF COURSE DESCRIPTION

Hole 1

Caution! Water obstacle on the right. Rough on the left side.

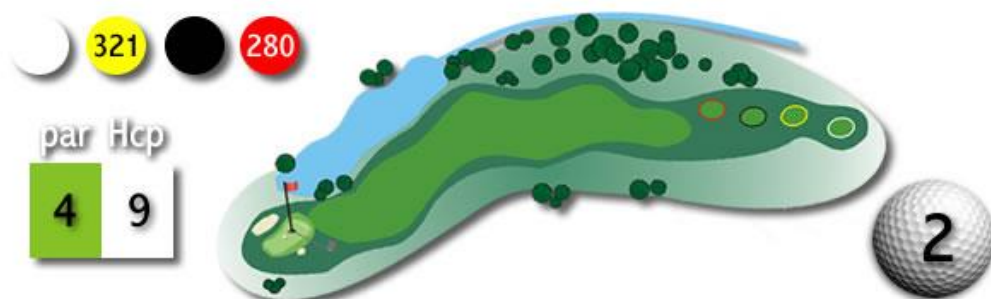
Pro tip: Put up on the left side so that you can easily get past the water hazards.



Hole 2

Do not play too far to the left, otherwise the bushes come into play.

Pro tip: Open on the left side of the fairway so that you can play more easily over the left corner.



Hole 3

Be careful when you tee off, as the wind comes from the seaside. As the ball flies higher over the trees, it drifts from left to right.

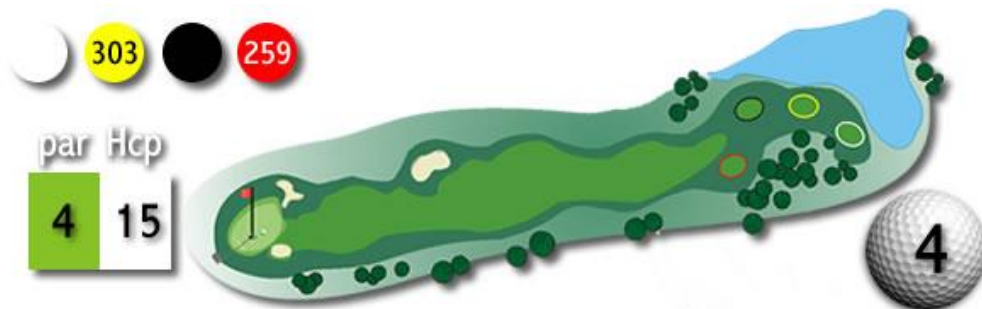
Pro tip: Since the wind slows the ball, you should take a lower club number.



Hole 4

Tee shot to the left. This is the better way to the green because of bunkers.

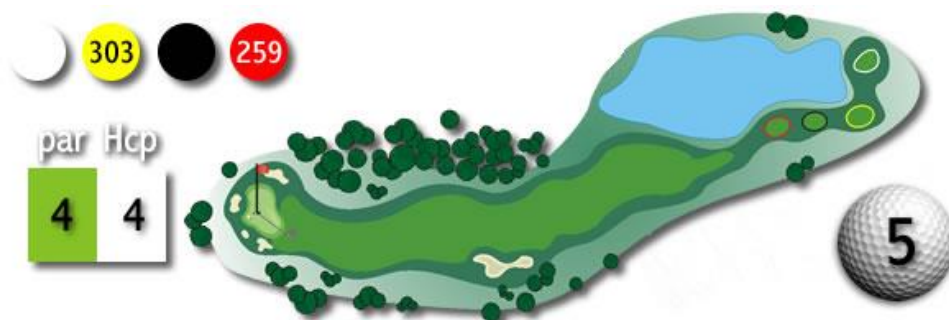
Pro tip: Correct choice of club to get over the bunker.



Hole 5

Teeing up on the left so that the ball does not end up in the "out of bounds" (left). The ball should be played towards the bunker on the left.

Pro tip: Ball should be tied higher than normal so that you can get over the water hazard.



Hole 6

Tee off on the right side, due to water hazards on the left side.

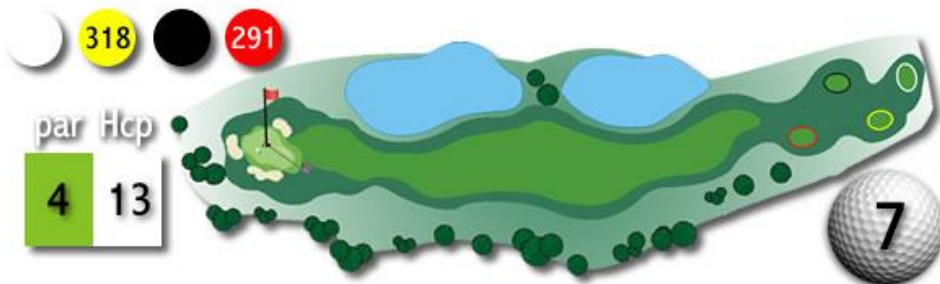
Pro tip: Get higher so you can get over the water hazard more easily.



Hole 7

You can reach the water hazard with a good tee shot. Stay on the left to make it easier to get to the green.

Pro tip: Put up on the right side so that you can better get to the left side.



Hole 8

Green is on 2 levels.

Pro tip: Be careful! The hole is longer than you might think.



Hole 9

Caution! Bunker and thick rough on the right.

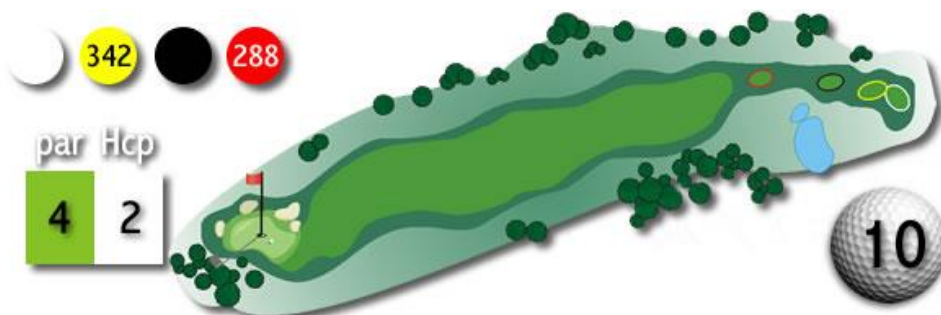
Pro tip: tee off to the left. Second shot should not be too aggressive, you need three shots to the green.



Hole 10

Tee shot to the right. Be careful when you hit the green because of the depression and several bunkers on the right.

Pro tip: Put your ball higher so that you can get over the gorge more easily.



Hole 11

Be careful! Don't play over the green. If too short, the ball remains in front of the green.

Pro tip: Tire on the right side, because of the bunker on the right.



Hole 12

Warning! Water hazard on the right.

Pro tip: Play on the right side so you can play on the left side more easily.



Hole 13

Warning! Water hazard behind the green. Bunker right in front of the green.

Pro tip: play the left side of the green.

Hole 14

Caution! "Out of Bounds" on the right.

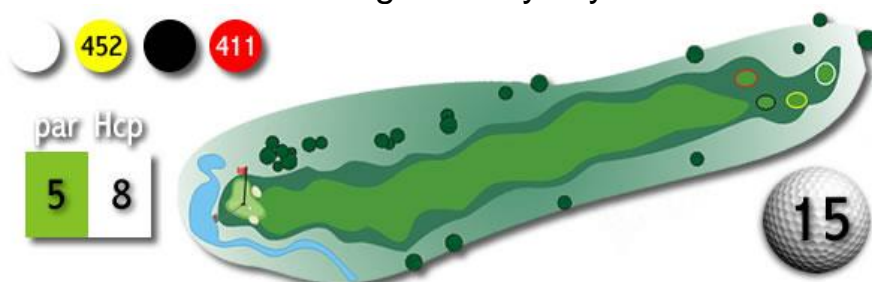
Pro tip: You should play on the left side.



Hole 15

When you tee off, stay on the right side and then play the second shot to the left side.

Pro tip: Don't play the second shot too aggressively, as you need three shots to get to the green anyway.



Hole 16

Tee off to the left as the balls bounce to the right.

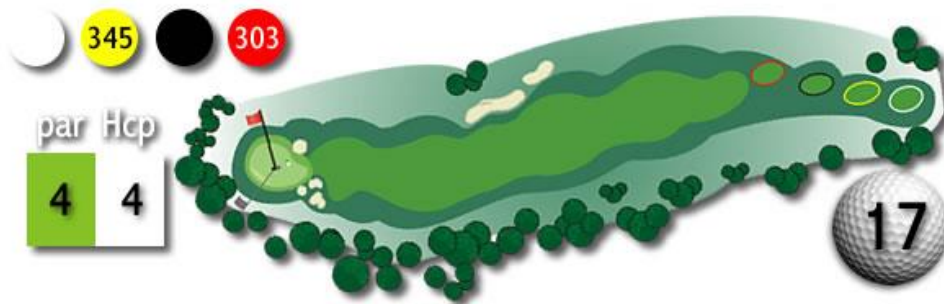
Pro tip: tee up on the right side so that the path to the green is wider.



Hole 17

Tee off towards the bunker on the right. Attention! There are several bunkers on the right.

Pro tip: The shot in the direction of the green must be made on the right, as there are several bunkers on the left.



Hole 18

Tee off to the left so that the ball bounces to the right.

Pro tip: Always play the ball on the left side to avoid the water hazard.
